



FAMILY COMMUNICATION AMID POLITICAL DIFFERENCES RESEARCH STUDY

The purpose of this research study is to learn more about how parents and adult children communicate during times of political tension.

We're especially interested in families with differing political views. Your input will help improve support for family relationships. Participation includes six weekly follow-up surveys, spanning over six weeks.

YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IF YOU:

- Are 18 years of age or older
- Are fluent in English and reside in the United States
- Have reliable internet access
- Have a parent or child who also meets the above criteria, speaks with you at least 3x per week, holds different political beliefs, is willing to participate with you, and with whom you've experienced political conflict in the past six months



PARTICIPANTS WILL BE OFFERED:

- Up to \$60 in compensation — \$10 for each of the 6 study components: six weekly follow-up surveys (up to \$120 per dyad).
- A chance to win an additional \$100 gift card — Dyads who complete all 6 components will be entered into a drawing for a bonus virtual gift card.
